Kakamega County Water and Sanitation Company Ltd has received funds from the Water Sector Trust Fund under **Up-scaling Basic Sanitation for Urban Poor (UBSUP) Project** and intends to use part of the funds to undertake the above named project.

1. **Kakamega County Water and Sanitation Company Ltd** invites sealed tenders for the **Construction of a Decentralized Waste Water Treatment Facility of 50 cubic meters in capacity (DTF₅₀) in Mumias town – Kakamega County**. The project entails construction of a 1 No. of Receiving Bay with Balancing Tank (RBBT), 1 No. of Settler (ST), 1 No. of Anaerobic Baffled Reactor (ABR), 2 No. of Vertical Flow Constructed Wetland (VFCW), 1 No. of Sludge Drying Bed (SDB), 1 No. of Incinerator, 1 No. of Operator House (OH) and Auxiliary works , such as Fencing, Gates, chambers.

3. **Minimum Qualification include but not limited** to the following
 - a) **The contractor should be registered with National Construction Authority** Under category NCA 7 or above strictly under Water works category and have current valid practicing License.
 - b) **Experience in at least Two (2)** (number) water and/ or waste water treatment facilities contracts, each of minimum value Kenya shillings **Fifteen Million (Kshs 15,000,000.00)** or equivalent.
 - c) Minimum average annual work turnover of Kenya Shillings **Thirty Million(Kshs.30,000,000.00).**
 - d) **Other requirements are outlined in the Bid Document.**

5. All Tenders must be accompanied by a **“tender Security”** of 2% of the Tender Sum in Kenya Shillings in form of **unconditional bank guarantee** from reputable bank selected by bidder and located in Kenya. The Bank must be registered by Central Bank of Kenya
6. Completed tenders must be delivered in hard copies to the address below on or before **Tuesday 10th March, 2020 at 12 noon.** East African Time. Electronic Tenders **will not** be permitted.
- 7 (a) There will be a Compulsory site visit and a pre-bidding meeting on Monday **2nd March 2020 from 11 am to 2:00pm EAT** at Mumias Water Supply offices opposite St. Anne’s Girls’ Primary School and the Proposed Site for the Construction of a DTF₅₀ in Camcon Estate, Mumias Town.
 - (b) Site visit shall be attended by a technical staff of the bidding entity. He or she will be required to provide a signed and stamped introductory letter printed on the letter head of the bidding entity, carry his or her original professional/academic certificate and original identity card or passport.
 - (c) Site visit certificate shall be issued by the procuring entity to the bidders who meet the criteria outlined in 7(b) above
8. Tenders will be opened immediately after the deadline date and time specified above or any deadline date and time specified later. Tenders will be publicly opened in the presence of the Tenderers’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend.
9. **All the pages** of the submitted Bid Documents **MUST** be serialised sequentially.
10. Late tenders will be automatically rejected.
